(i.e., RHIA, RHIT, CCS or CCA exams only) Schools MUST be based in South Carolina, students must be members of both AHIMA and SCHIMA, and all requirements described in the application cover page must be met in order for students to be eligible for consideration for award. Scholarship awards are made payable directly to the credential examination administration agency. If a student applies for early testing and is later awarded a scholarship, SCHIMA will directly reimburse the student once proof of taking the appropriate credentialing exam is provided to the organization. Awards are not transferrable. Number of awards disbursed will vary by year based on fund availability and applicant pool. Awards may not be given every year.*
